Open Public Meeting Minutes

November 6, 2025

A. Call to Order:

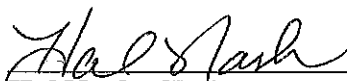

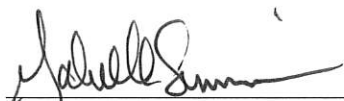
