

On August 29, 2018, the Board granted a full pardon with restoration of all civil and political rights to Lutoyua Neocan Thompson, #806918. Following the Board's action, Bureau of Pardons and Paroles staff identified a substantive error on the Board's action sheet granting the pardon, namely that the Board stated that the applicant was restored all civil and political rights, including relief from firearms disabilities. Due to the applicant's federal conviction and subsequent loss of rights under the Federal Gun Control Act, the Board had no jurisdiction to order relief from firearms disabilities and the pardon is void as a matter of law.

Therefore, the Board hereby votes to allow Bureau of Pardons and Paroles staff to reprocess the applicant's file for pardon consideration immediately, to be set for a hearing as soon as statutorily possible.




