

ALABAMA BOARD OF PARDONS & PAROLES

Open Public Meeting Minutes

July 28, 2026

A. Call to Order:

1. The Alabama Board of Pardons and Paroles called to order its open public meeting on this date at 8:33A.M., 301 South Ripley Street, Montgomery, AL 36104 for the purpose of conducting its regular parole/pardon hearings, as prescribed by Alabama Code, Title 15, Chapter 22. Board members present were: Hal Nash, Chairperson, Gabrelle Simmons, Board Member and Jennifer Conway, Board Member.
2. The Board met to discuss the attached agenda, with the action taken by the Board recorded by the Board's secretary, Nicole Lewis.

B. Board Business: The Board approved minutes from previous meeting of July 27, 2026, moved by Hal Nash and seconded by Gabrelle Simmons which was majority vote.

The Board voted and approved to withdraw the Parole Officer's Authorization of Arrest Warrant and Mashanta Williams, AIS# 301197 be released from Homewood City Jail. (See Attached Board Order)

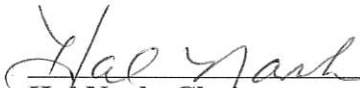

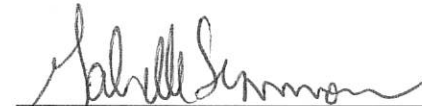

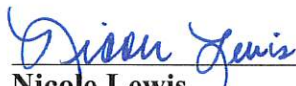

BOARD ORDER

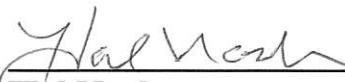

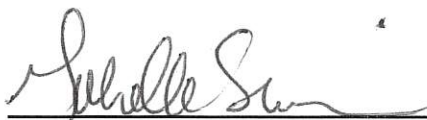
The Board voted and approved to withdraw the Parole Officer's Authorization of Arrest Warrant and **Mashanta Williams** be released from Homewood City Jail.

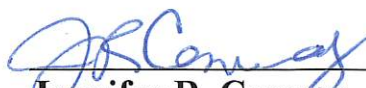
