

ALABAMA BOARD OF PARDONS & PAROLES

Open Public Meeting Minutes

August 25, 2026

A. Call to Order:

1. The Alabama Board of Pardons and Paroles called to order its open public meeting on this date at 8:30A.M., 301 South Ripley Street, Montgomery, AL 36104 for the purpose of conducting its regular parole/pardon hearings, as prescribed by Alabama Code, Title 15, Chapter 22. 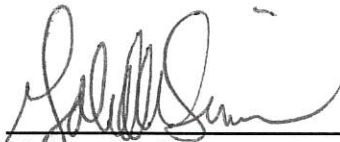
The Board voted and approved to withdraw the Parole Officer's Authorization of Arrest Warrant and **Christopher D. Smith** be released from Lawrence County Jail.

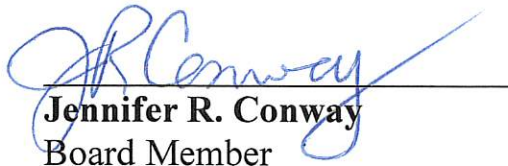
