Open Public Meeting Minutes

December 8, 2022

A. Call to Order:







In the interim, a corresponding recommendation for revision to the current policy shall be provided to the Board for review and approval. In no case shall a Directive be effective for more than 30-days.

Adoption of the Probation and Parole Officer Manual is recommended.


