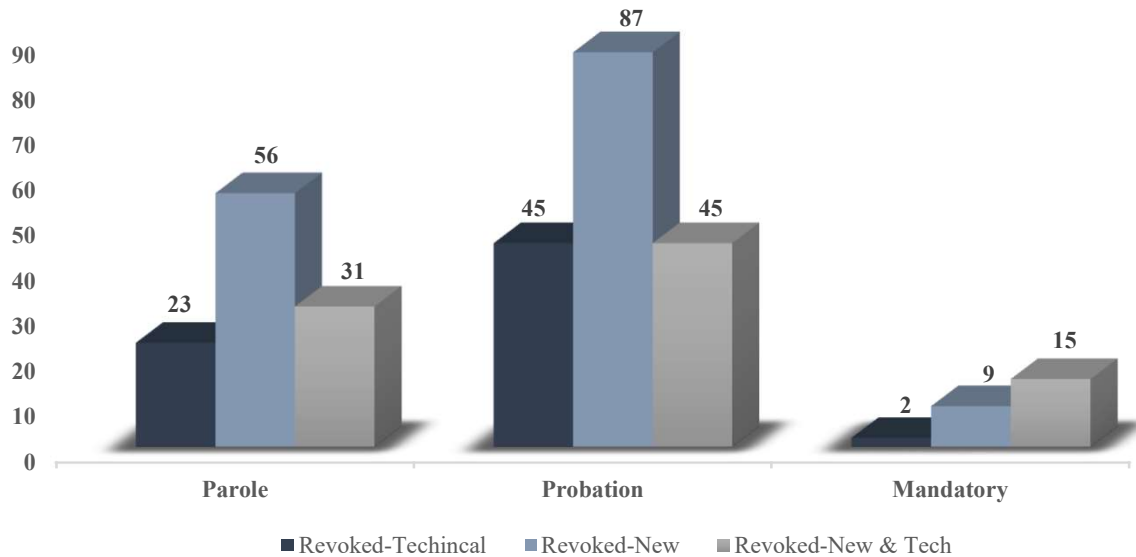

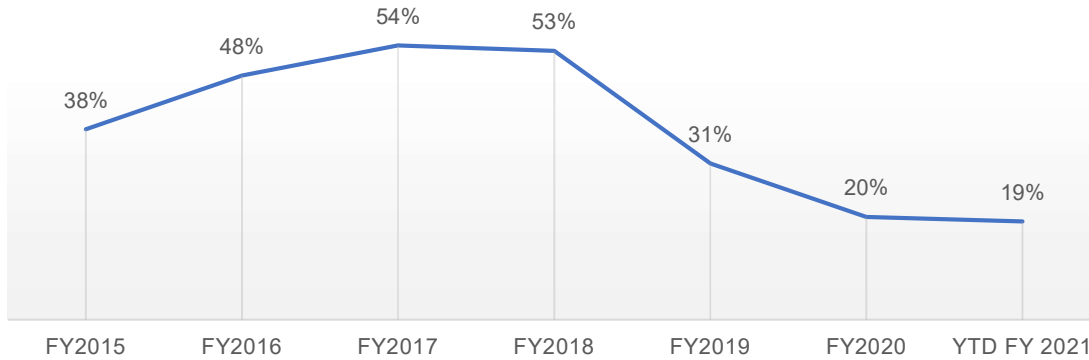

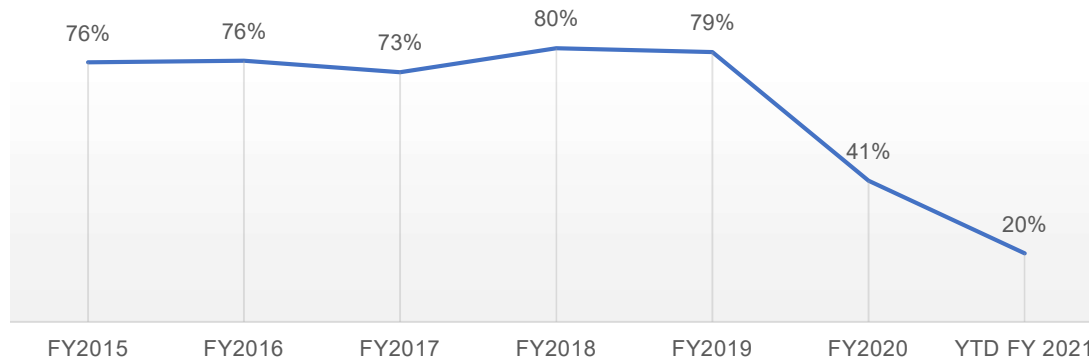
FY2015 - FY 2021 Grant Rates

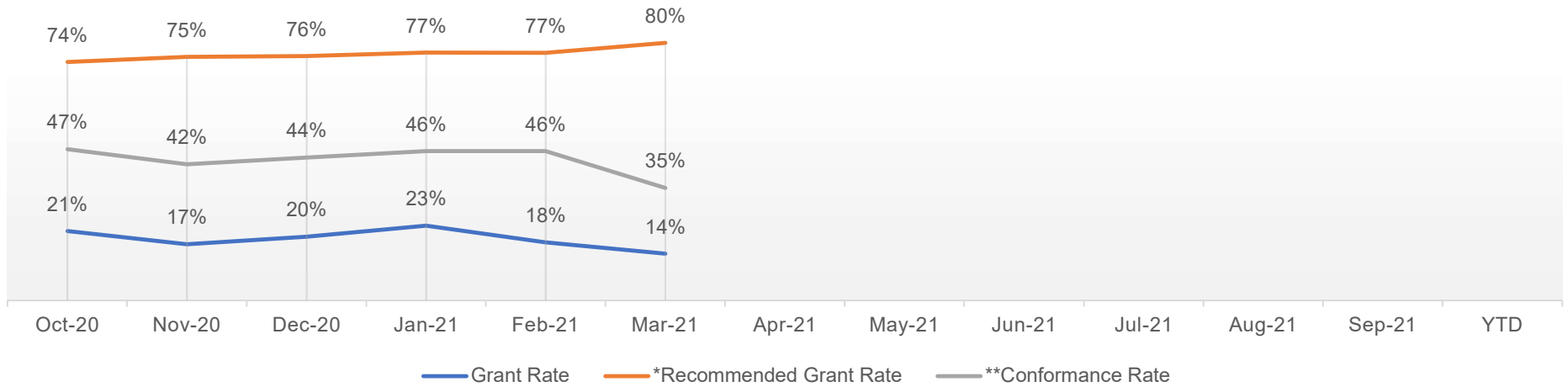

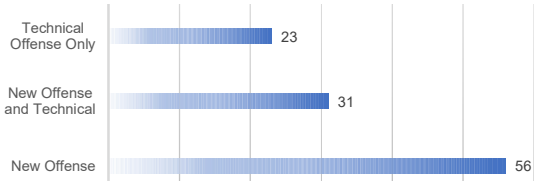

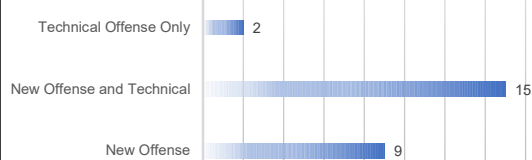

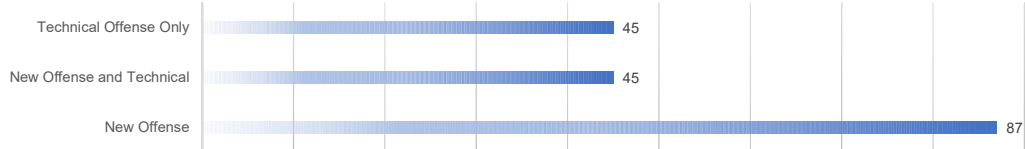

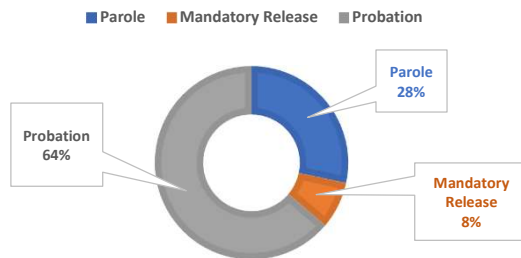
