Open Public Meeting Minutes

October 12, 2021

A. Call to Order:


G. Adjournment:

The Alabama Board of Pardons and Paroles met on this 28th day of **September 2021**, in open public meeting, at which time the following Board Members were present: Leigh Gwathney, Chair, Dwayne Spurlock, Associate Member, and Darryl Littleton, Associate Member.

On September 28, 2021, the Board granted the pardon consideration for Willie Lee Garner AIS# 110337, which included gun rights. Mr. Garner was attempting to obtain a pistol permit and was denied. The reason was due to having a Domestic Violence conviction out of Municipal Court. Therefore, The Board does not have jurisdiction to grant gun rights because of this. Bureau of Pardons and Paroles staff obtained additional information verifying this and ask to have Mr. Garner's pardon be reconsidered without gun rights being given.

Therefore, the Board hereby votes to change the continuance date for the above case to
