Open Public Meeting Minutes

January 4, 2022

A. Call to Order:

1. The Alabama Board of Pardons and Paroles called to order its open public meeting on this date at 8:20 A.M., 100 Capitol Commerce Blvd. Montgomery, AL 36117 for the purpose of conducting its regular parole/pardon hearings, as prescribed by Alabama Code, Title 15, Chapter 22. Eric Scott Wells (AIS# 299526) was considered for parole on 12-9-2021, denied, and reset for further parole consideration on the Board's December 2026 docket.


Mr. Wells is serving a 12-year prison term for Manufacturing a Controlled Substance (meth.). Under Alabama law an inmate convicted of a nonviolent offense with a sentence of 20-years or less shall be reconsidered no more than 2-years after such parole denial. *Ala. Code* §15-22-37(b)(4). The Board's action in setting Mr. Wells next parole consideration in five years is contrary to state law. Mr. Wells should have received a 2-year setoff.

It is therefore **ORDERED**, that Mr. Wells' five year set-off be corrected and he be set for further parole consideration in December 2023.

Parole for Jonathan W. Madewell, AIS 229923 was revoked for a parole violation on September 10, 2020, with further consideration in one year.
