

# ALABAMA BOARD OF PARDONS & PAROLES

## Open Public Meeting Minutes

January 25, 2022

### A. Call to Order:

1. The Alabama Board of Pardons and Paroles called to order its open public meeting on this date at 8:10 A.M., 100 Capitol Commerce Blvd. Montgomery, AL 36117 for the purpose of conducting its regular parole/pardon hearings, as prescribed by Alabama Code, Title 15, Chapter 22. Board members present were: Leigh Gwathney, Chairman, Dwayne Spurlock, Board Member and Darryl Littleton, Board Member.






