

ALABAMA BOARD OF PARDONS & PAROLES

Open Public Meeting Minutes

August 25, 2022

A. Call to Order:

1. The Alabama Board of Pardons and Paroles called to order its open public meeting on this date at 8:54 A.M., 100 Capitol Commerce Blvd. Montgomery, AL 36117 for the purpose of conducting its regular parole/pardon hearings, as prescribed by Alabama Code, Title 15, Chapter 22. Board members present were: Leigh Gwathney, Chairperson, Dwayne Spurlock, Board Member and Darryl Littleton, Board Member.
2. The Board met to discuss the attached agenda, with the action taken by the Board recorded by the Board's secretary, Nicole Lewis.

Parole for **Kenneth Thompson, AIS 239570** was revoked on September 29, 2021, for a parole violation with further consideration in four years. The Board has received new information concerning the parole violation and the sanction imposed. Based on the new information, and upon reconsideration of all the relevant facts, the Board finds that the charge(s) remain proved; however, the action revoking Thompson was in error. Therefore, the Board voids the order of September 29, 2021, revoking parole. The Board votes to order time in confinement of 45 days as an intermediate sanction for the parole violation. Thompson will be given credit for time previously served and reinstated to parole with his previous conditions of parole including programming at DRC.

Therefore, the Board **ORDERS** that the Bureau notify the Alabama Department of Corrections of Thompson's reinstatement to parole.
