

ALABAMA BOARD OF PARDONS & PAROLES

Open Public Meeting Minutes

May 11, 2023

A. Call to Order:

1. The Alabama Board of Pardons and Paroles called to order its open public meeting on this date at 9:04 A.M., 100 Capitol Commerce Blvd., Montgomery, AL 36117 for the purpose of conducting its regular parole/pardon hearings, as prescribed by Alabama Code, Title 15, Chapter 22. Board members present were: Leigh Gwathney, Chairperson, Darryl Littleton, Board Member and Kim Davidson, Board Member.
2. The Board met to discuss the attached agenda, with the action taken by the Board recorded by the Board's secretary, Nicole Lewis.

B. Board Business: The Board approved minutes from previous meeting of May 10, 2023, moved by Darryl Littleton and seconded by Kim Davidson which was majority vote.

Parole for Paul Donat Campbell, AIS 326722 was revoked on May 4, 2023, for a parole violation with no further consideration before EOS.
