

# ALABAMA BOARD OF PARDONS & PAROLES

## Open Public Meeting Minutes

June 29, 2023

### A. Call to Order:


The Alabama Board of Pardons and Paroles met on this 29<sup>th</sup> day of June, 2023, in open public meeting, at which time the following Board Members were present: Leigh Gwathney, Chair, Darryl Littleton, Associate Member, and Kim Davidson, Associate Member.

Upon the recommendation of Director Cam Ward, and in compliance with Executive Order 728, to include additional revisions deemed necessary, the Board votes to approve changes to the Probation and Parole Officer Manual and the Personnel Manual related to the use of state vehicles. The following provisions will be repealed and replaced:

- Probation and Parole Current Officer Manual Section 10 in its entirety.
- Personnel Manual: Chapter 10, Section XI in its entirety.


Pursuant to the authority granted to the Director of Pardons and Paroles, Director Ward will implement the new policy for the Personnel Manual with an effective date of July 1, 2023. However, Sections 10.4 through 10.8 of the Probation and Parole Officer Manual shall take effect September 1, 2023 to allow for proper training. On those dates all the replaced versions of the manual are rescinded.

Adoption of the proposed changes to the vehicle use policies contained in the Probation and Parole Officer Manual and the Personnel Manual are recommended.
