

ALABAMA BOARD OF PARDONS & PAROLES

Open Public Meeting Minutes

August 1, 2023

A. Call to Order:

1. The Alabama Board of Pardons and Paroles called to order its open public meeting on this date at 8:22A.M., 100 Capitol Commerce Blvd., Montgomery, AL 36117 for the purpose of conducting its regular parole/pardon hearings, as prescribed by Alabama Code, Title 15, Chapter 22. Board members present were: Leigh Gwathney, Chairperson and Darryl Littleton, Board Member.
2. The Board met to discuss the attached agenda, with the action taken by the Board recorded by the Board's secretary, Nicole Lewis.

B. Board Business: The Board approved minutes from previous meeting of July 27, 2023, moved by Leigh Gwathney and seconded by Darryl Littleton which was majority vote.

Parole for Gus Johnson, AIS# 108854 was revoked on May 5, 2021, for a parole violation. The Board has received new information concerning the parole violation, the criminal investigation, and the sanction imposed. The Board votes to order time in confinement of 45 days as an intermediate sanction for the parole violation. Johnson will be given credit for time previously served and reinstatement to parole with his previous conditions of supervision. Therefore, the Board orders that the Bureau notify the Alabama Department of Corrections of Johnson's reinstatement to parole. (See Attached Board Order)







The Board has received new information concerning the parole violation, the criminal investigation, and the sanction imposed. Upon reconsideration of all the relevant facts, the Board finds that the charged parole violation remains proven. However, in light of new information, the Board voids the order of May 5, 2021, revoking parole. The Board votes to order time in confinement of 45 days as an intermediate sanction for the parole violation. Johnson will be given credit for time previously served and reinstated to parole with his previous conditions of supervision.






