

ALABAMA BOARD OF PARDONS & PAROLES

Open Public Meeting Minutes

September 21, 2023

A. Call to Order:

1. The Alabama Board of Pardons and Paroles called to order its open public meeting on this date at 9:22A.M., 100 Capitol Commerce Blvd., Montgomery, AL 36117 for the purpose of conducting its regular parole/pardon hearings, as prescribed by Alabama Code, Title 15, Chapter 22. Board members present were: Leigh Gwathney, Chairperson, Darryl Littleton, Board Member, and Gabrelle Simmons, Board Member.
2. The Board met to discuss the attached agenda, with the action taken by the Board recorded by the Board's secretary, Nicole Lewis.

B. Board Business: The Board approved minutes from previous meeting of September 20, 2023, moved by Darryl Littleton and seconded by Gabrelle Simmons which was majority vote.

Parole for Anthony Leon Law, AIS # 169220 was revoked on June 15, 2022. However, in light of new information, the Board voids the order of June 15, 2022, revoking parole. The Board votes to order time in confinement of 45 days as an intermediate sanction for the parole violation. Law will be given credit for time previously served. In addition, because the new information received by the Board indicates that Law plead guilty to at least one new criminal offense, the Board refers this matter back to Field Operations to conduct a review to determine whether a new parole violation charge should be made, and to hold a new parole court hearing as soon as practical, should the facts warrant one or more parole violation charges. 





The Alabama Board of Pardons and Paroles met on this 21st day of September 2023, in open public meeting, at which time the following Board Members were present: Leigh Gwathney, Chair, Darryl Littleton, Associate Member, and Gabrelle Simmons, Associate Member.

Parole for **ANTHONY LEON LAW, AIS 169220** was revoked on June 15, 2022, following a parole court hearing on three alleged parole violations: 1) failure to report; 2) new criminal charge, certain person prohibited from possessing a firearm; and 3) new criminal charge, attempted murder and a finding by the hearing officer that the failure to report charge was proven, but the other two charges were not proven due to insufficient evidence.

The Board has received new information concerning the parole violations, the underlying criminal investigations, and the subsequent criminal prosecution. Upon consideration of the relevant facts, the Board finds that the first charge remains proven. However, in light of new information, the Board voids the order of June 15, 2022, revoking parole. The Board votes to order time in confinement of 45 days as an intermediate sanction for the parole violation. Law will be given credit for time previously served.

In addition, because the new information received by the Board indicates that Law plead guilty to at least one new criminal offense, the Board refers this matter back to Field Operations to conduct a review to determine whether a new parole violation charge should be made, and to hold a new parole court hearing as soon as practical, should the facts warrant one or more parole violation charges.




