## **Open Public Meeting Minutes**

The Alabama Board of Pardons and Paroles met on this 15<sup>th</sup> day of Oct. 2025, in open public meeting, at which time the following Board Members were present: Hal Nash, Chair; Darryl Littleton, Member; and Gabrelle Simmons, Member.

The Bureau of Pardons and Paroles received a letter from Mr. Porter on 9-22-2025 claiming he was improperly revoked from parole on 7-9-2025. He claims he was revoked for 2-years on a technical violation when Alabama's parole statutes only allow a maximum of 45-days. *Ala. Code* §15-22-32.

The Bureau has researched Mr. Porter's case and determined there is sufficient cause to vacate the revocation order dated 7-9-2025, declaring him delinquent, and conducting a new revocation hearing. Based on the recommendation of the Bureau the Board takes the following actions.

It is **Ordered** that the Board's order revoking Mr. Porter's parole dated 7-9-2025 be vacated. Mr. Porter will be declared delinquent, and the Bureau will conduct another parole revocation hearing in compliance with Alabama parole statutes and which affords Mr. Porter all the due process protections to which he is entitled.
