

ALABAMA BOARD OF PARDONS & PAROLES

Open Public Meeting Minutes

October 7, 2025

A. Call to Order:

1. The Alabama Board of Pardons and Paroles called to order its open public meeting on this date at 8:30A.M., 301 South Ripley Street, Montgomery, AL 36104 for the purpose of conducting its regular parole/pardon hearings, as prescribed by Alabama Code, Title 15, Chapter 22. Board members present were: Hal Nash, Chairperson, Darryl Littleton, Board Member and Gabrelle Simmons, Board Member.
2. The Board met to discuss the attached agenda, with the action taken by the Board recorded by the Board's secretary, Nicole Lewis.

B. Board Business: The Board approved minutes from previous meeting of October 2, 2025, moved by Hal Nash and seconded by Gabrelle Simmons which was majority vote.

The Board voted and approved that Keith Chambers, AIS# 157265 will be released from the obligation of completing the PREP Center to attend his approved home plan when he can continue to receive the medical attention required for his condition. (See Attached Board Order)

Upon recommendation of Director Cam Ward, the Board hereby votes to revise Section 8.1 of the Alabama Bureau of Pardons and Paroles Officer Manual by replacing subsection H in its entirety with the attached provisions reflecting changes to the law made by the enactment of Alabama Code § 15-22-26.3. H. SHARING OF EM DATA

1. It is recognized that outside agencies and entities may seek to obtain EM data created and maintained in accordance with this policy for various purposes. EM data shall be provided only when required/permitted by law, in accordance with this policy or with the written approval of the Director in consultation with the General Counsel.
2. As used in this subsection, "EM data" refers strictly to location information only and does not extend to any journal entries, officer notes, documents or any other information contained in a probation or parole file.
3. Supervision Use: EM data may always be used for supervision purposes. This includes the proactive sharing of EM data with outside law enforcement agencies when the EM officer, with approval of the responsible District Manager and in consultation with and approval of the EM Program Manager, believes sharing is necessary to further a supervision purpose and/or required by law. Any question regarding the propriety of a disclosure shall be referred to the General Counsel.
4. Requests from Outside Law Enforcement Agencies.
 - a. The EM Program Manager shall, in accordance with this policy and in consultation with the General Counsel, create and maintain a form for outside law enforcement agencies to use for purposes of requesting EM data.
 - b. Officers receiving a request for EM data from another law enforcement agency will provide a copy of the approved form with instructions to return the completed form to the officer.
 - c. Officers receiving a completed EM data request form will:
 - i. Scan and upload a copy of the request into the offender management system under name of the EM Offender whose data has been requested; and
 - ii. forward the request up the chain of command to their District Manager who will forward it along with any comments/recommendations to the EM Program Manager.
 - d. Upon receipt of a properly completed request form, the EM Program Manager may approve requests submitted on the Bureau form that meet the following criteria:
 - i. a certification from the requesting law enforcement agency that GPS data is probative of an active criminal investigation; and
 - ii. a certification from the requesting law enforcement agency that upon the Bureau's request, the requesting outside law enforcement agency shall provide a copy of the investigation upon completion and fully cooperate in any resulting parole violation proceedings.
 - e. The EM Program Manager or designee shall provide approved GPS data to the requesting agency's listed point of contact and document the transmittal in the offender management system in the EM Offender's journal notes.
 - d. If the EM Program Manager denies a request, s/he will notify the requesting agency's point of contact, explain the reasons for denial, and document the refusal in the EM Offender's journal notes.
 - e. The EM Program Manager will consult with the General Counsel when in doubt as to whether a request should be approved.
 - f. Blanket requests such as those seeking EM data for all offenders for a

particular period of time shall not be honored unless approved by the Director in consultation with the General Counsel.

5. All Other EM Data Requests:

- a. No other EM data requests shall be honored, including those resulting from an Open Records Act request, without the approval of the Director in consultation with the General Counsel.
 - b. Any officer receiving a subpoena for EM data from any court shall immediately forward the subpoena to the Legal Division with a copy sent through the chain of command.

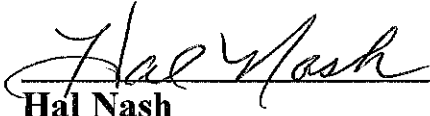

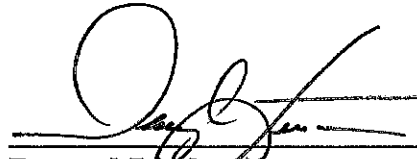

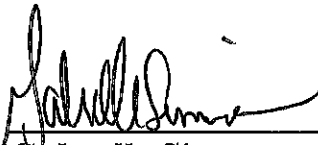
