Open Public Meeting Minutes

September 25, 2025

A. Call to Order:

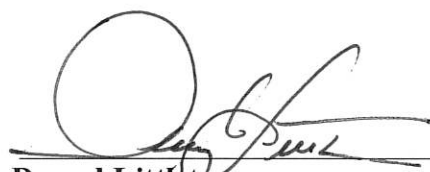

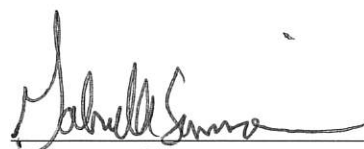
