

# **ALABAMA BOARD OF PARDONS & PAROLES**

## **Open Public Meeting Minutes**

**June 25, 2025**

**A. Call to Order:**

1. The Alabama Board of Pardons and Paroles called to order its open public meeting by quorum on this date at 9:21A.M., 301 South Ripley Street, Montgomery, AL 36104 for the purpose of conducting its regular parole/pardon hearings, as prescribed by Alabama Code, Title 15, Chapter 22.
