#### **Open Public Meeting Minutes**

#### August 27, 2025

#### A. Call to Order:

The Alabama Board of Pardons and Paroles called to order its open public meeting on this date at 8:30A.M., 301 South Ripley Street, Montgomery, AL 36104 for the purpose of conducting its regular parole/pardon hearings, as prescribed by Alabama Code, Title 15, Chapter 22. # MINUTE ENTRY & BOARD ORDER

The Alabama Board of Pardons and Paroles met on this 26th day of August 2025, in open public meeting, at which time the following Board Members were present: Hal Nash, Chair, Darryl Littleton, Associate Member, and Gabrelle Simmons, Associate Member.

The Bureau of Pardons and Paroles received a request from a current parolee, **Timothy Paul Smith**, AIS# 212317, who seeks to have past "deadtime" reinstated to his sentence. Mr. Smith was declared delinquent by the Parole Board on 02/28/2011 for failing to report upon release from prison. Parole Court was conducted on 07/06/2011, wherein the hearing officer found insufficient evidence to support the charge. The hearing officer further recommended the charge not be considered by the Board and that Mr. Smith be "continued on parole". However, the Board Action sheet dated 08/02/2011 reflects Mr. Smith was "re-instated" to parole. This resulted in Mr. Smith being charge with "deadtime" from 02/28/2011 to 08/02/2011.

The Board and DOC use these terms as a term of art. "Continued on parole" means a parolee is continued as if there was no violation, therefore creating no "deadtime" issue. "Reinstated to parole" means the Board is choosing to reinstate the parolee, after proving the violation, and "deadtime" does go against the parolee's sentence. If parole court finds insufficient evidence to prove a parolee violated parole the Board only has authority to "continue on parole" and any "deadtime" cannot be used against the parolee's sentence.

Considering the above, the Board lacked authority to "reinstate parole" and the Board Action sheet dated 08/02/2011 should have reflected that Mr. Smith was "continued on parole".

Therefore, the Board **ORDERS** that the Board Action sheet dated 08/02/2011 be amended to reflect that Mr. Smith was "continued on parole". The Board further directs the Bureau to notify DOC of this correction and recommend DOC recalculate Mr. Smith's time to properly reflect that he should not have been charged with "deadtime" from 02/28/2011 through 08/02/2011.
